SYPHILIS is a sexually transmitted disease (STD) and is increasing in women in San Francisco County. **Syphilis symptoms** may appear and then disappear and may include:

- a painless sore inside or near the mouth, genitals or anal areas
- a rash that appears on the palms of hands, bottom of feet, or on the body between the arm pits and upper thighs

If a woman is infected with syphilis while pregnant, it can lead to birth defects, miscarriage, premature birth and stillbirth.

Good News: Syphilis can be treated and cured even during pregnancy with a shot of antibiotics.
